Conference costs:

Conference costs and accommodation are covered by the hosting organisation. Travel costs are covered by the participants / sending National Agencies.

Covid regulations

All participants will be kindly asked to provide proof of their full vaccination against Covid-19. The current situation is:

- Full vaccination protection is given if the second vaccination is more than 14 days and less than 90 days ago, this also refers to recovery after a Corona infection.
- No restrictions apply to participants who have received a booster vaccination (the 3rd vaccination) respectively receipt of 2 vaccinations after a Corona infection. They do not need to show a negative antigen test.
- If you can't proof full vaccination protection a negative antigen test (not older than 24 hours) is required. If the infection rates keep that high we might ask for a negative antigen test for all in any way.

Changes to these regulations are still possible up to the event.
