<b>Students with lower socio-economic status</b>	A student is a recipient of state social benefit	- certificate confirming that a student is a recipient of state social benefit

<p><b>Students with a status of a refugee, an asylum seeker or a migrant</b></p>		<p>Decision on granting asylum or subsidiary protection;          - residency permit.          In addition, it is important to be able to prove one's identity in the form of:          - asylum seeker travel document;          - special passport for foreigners;          - another identity document.</p>
<p><b>Students whose physical, mental or health-related condition is such that their participation in the project/mobility activity would not be possible without extra financial or additional support</b></p>	<p>Students with special needs, i.e. all students who receive inclusion support, as well as students who do not receive for inclusion support (e.g. special diet), but through this category receive the top-up for students with fewer opportunities.</p>	<p>Certificate issued by a general practitioner or a specialist doctor (the original document is requested, not older than 6 months) and the decision of the competent institution/state body showing the percentage and type of disability (copy, if applicable).</p>
